Footnotes

EDDINGTON'S NOTE angled out six wide at the top of the stretch, rallied and drew off while ridden out for the win. SHUSH UP saved ground, rallied at the quarter pole but was no threat to the winner. OVER THE COUNTER was off a step slow, was unrushed early, then improved position late while nine wide, brushing with a rival late. WILD FOR LOVE bid seven wide at the top of the stretch, then was brushed late. STORM ON BYE stalked the pace between rivals, then lacked a late bid. BLUESTARBABY pressed the early pace, bid to be clear on the turn, then gave way late. BON CHANCE pressed the early pace three wide, then gave way on the far turn. MIDNIGHT LARK was not a factor. BABY PRINCESS vied inside, then gave way in the stretch.
