SECRET JACKPOT settled into stride along the rail, worked his way to the outside down the backside, gained ground four wide in the turn, swung six wide for the drive and prevailed in a charging rally to be going best of all at the wire. INDIAN EMPIRE reserved off the early pace, moved three wide through the turn to gain a striking position, collared the leaders at the eighth pole and was outfinished inside the final hundred yards by the winner. SUPREMACY rushed to the lead shortly away from the gate, opened a clear margin into the turn, dueled with TENN ROSES through the turn to the eighth pole and battled gamely while weakening in the final yards. FARMINGTON stalked the pace through the turn while losing positions, maintained ground saving trip along the rail and mounted a strong final bid along the inside. TENN ROSES broke alertly, settled to be just off the pacesetter to the turn, moved to engage that one in the turn, dueled to the eighth pole garnering a momentary lead and weakened late. CAPTAIN SPITLER slow early to be at the back of the field, swung wide in the lane to make a belated rally. ADJOURNMENT tracked the pace racing four wide through the turn and faded in the drive. MUKAMER chased the leaders from between horses, set to early drive mid-turn, and lacked any response in the stretch. SHAMELESS RISK trailed and was no factor.
