NASREEN stalked the pace three wide, then drew off late under a mild drive. BREZING RAIN stalked the pace four wide, then couldn't match strides in the stretch. PRIMAL BABY saved ground, then angled out five wide in the stretch and rallied belatedly. VEGAS WEDDING stalked the pace inside, then faded in the stretch. L D'S GALAXY saved ground, then lacked a late bid. BRANDYS SECRET vied inside before giving way in the drive. UNWAVERING HOPE bore in at the start, vied between rivals, then gave way in the drive. BECATA bore out at the start, then was not a factor. PURE POLISHED was off awkwardly and was squeezed back at the start, bore out and raced wide while trailing.
