BRASS BAY broke in at the start and bumped hard with MALKEINU then chased the pace while racing two wide, rallied on the turn to take command then drew off in mid stretch and was kept to task to hold sway. MALKEINU was bumped and wiped out at the start then was settled, started a rally on the turn while two wide, was gaining ground strongly to finish well. SYLVIA'S FORTE was wiped out at the start and taken up off heels then was far back on the run down the backstretch, rallied on the turn and angled out to be six wide in upper stretch, closed ground willingly on the outside and finished fast. FORBIDDEN DREAMS was allowed to settled while racing three wide on the turn then raced evenly in the stretch. DIP MY BEAK was bumped at the start and knocked sideways then was settled and failed to menace in the stretch. KNIGHT SHOT raced on the inside on the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. QUICK SHOOTER set a fast pace, drew clear heading into the turn then stopped in the stretch drive. WHAT A NOTION chased the early pace while racing three wide, was through after a half and stopped in the stretch. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the start. A jockey claim of foul was lodged by the rider of MALKEINU against the rider of BRASS BAY for interference at the start. After reviewing the films, BRASS BAY was disqualified from first and was placed third for interference at the start.
