ZEE ARE ONE unhurried early,had a steady advance,closed willingly. EDISTO BEACH set the early pace,dueled briefly when challenged on the far turn,weakened in the stretch. AVARAS had good position and saved ground,finished evenly. MONARCH DESTINY was well placed from four wide,lacked a late response. GRAVITAS trailed early,was hard ridden entering the far turn,failed to respond. MR. RAVEN showed little.
