BARTLETTS sprinted away to take command nearing the five-eighths pole, opened a clear advantage, dueled with the runner-up from the quarter pole home, lost his lead at the eighth pole and re-rallied gamely to claim the victory. WILL RUN FOR BEER pressed the pacesetter into the turn, dueled with the winner from the quarter pole, taking the lead briefly in mid-stretch and was outfinished in the final hundred yards. CAPT. ZIPPOUNAS allowed to settle into stride early, circled three wide in the turn to challenge and leveled off in the drive. TANGLED SHEETS reserved off the pace, saved ground through the turn, angled out splitting horses and made steady gains down the stretch. LAST EMPIRE raced mid-pack to the turn, moved up racing three wide in the turn and finished evenly. EXXEL slow early near rear of the field, made a five wide mild rally in the lane. MR. SEGRETTO away at the back of the field, made a late gain in the stretch posing no threat. IL VAGABONDO chased the leaders from between horses to the turn and gradually faded. BEANTOWN CAT chased the pace for a half mile along the rail and flattened out in the drive. BOB THE POOL MAN flashed brief speed, dropped to back of field and was no factor.
