Footnotes

WIDE RECEIVER stalked the leaders through the first turn, rushed up between horses at the half mile pole to press the leader, settled off the pace again when clear of traffic, assumed command from the tiring leader at the top of the lane, dueled with the runner-up to the wire and prevailed in a hard fought drive. AMERICAN DOE reserved off the pace to the far turn, circled five wide to mount a strong challenge on the outside, collared the leader at the eighth pole and failed to get past the winner in a good effort. BESAME SUANCES tracked the leaders down the backside, raced up four wide in the turn, challenged in the lane and lacked the needed response in the final eighth. L. G.'S FLASH dropped off the pace for the run down the backside and made a mild rally in the stretch. CUP OF WHYS slow early at the rear of the field and passed tired rivals in the stretch while racing evenly. MASTER DAN broke alertly, took command dueling on the lead for a half mile, opened a clear lead and flattened out nearing the quarter pole. TASTE THE TRUTH pressed the pace for a half mile and came up empty.
