EXOTIC BLOOM was settled early then kept to the inside on the far turn saving ground, rallied coming out of the far turn, angled out to be two wide and split rivals then dug in gamely in late stretch to prove best in the end. ROLLICKING AFFAIR was sent right to the front to set the pace, was well handled then was in a long sustained drive while inside in the stretch, was all out in late stretch but hung in the end. VALLEY LOOT stalked the pace while racing three wide, rallied on the far turn then was in a long sustained drive and gamely dug in but tired in deep stretch. CHEROKEE QUEEN was allowed to settle in the early going while racing four wide, made a strong bid on the far turn and was in a long drive then tired in late stretch. NIJINSKY BALLETT reared at the break then was unhurried early, made a mild rally while three wide on the far turn but was no threat in the stretch. SKY MOM was allowed to settle on the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. BOB'S DYLAN chased the early pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the far turn while between rivals then faltered in the stretch drive. NO USE DENYING broke slowly from the gate then was unhurried early, raced four wide on the backstretch then gave way.
