BARAT was clear early, was given a breather nearing the final turn, then drew off in the stretch, winning easily. VICAR STREET bid inside at the quarter pole, then was no threat to the winner. RUNAWAY BRUTE bid four wide at the quarter pole, then was no threat. FRATELLO stalked the pace, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered in the stretch. SHAKEYOGROOVETHING stalked the pace for a half mile before giving way. WHERE'S THE BEEF stalked the pace for a half mile before fading. VLAST and WATCH ROCK were not factors. TETON SUN was through early and was distanced.
