ITS HIS TIME broke well from the outside to stalk the early pace, inched closer entering the turn, responded to gain a short advantage at the eighth pole then was all out late to prevail. MATTY'S SONG away in good order from the inside, chased the early pace from just off the rail, altered outside entering the turn, responded when asked upper stretch and found his best stride too late. HAIL TO THE CAT dueled from the outside for the early lead, remained a forward factor entering the drive but could not match strides. GO BUCKY GO dueled from the inside for the early lead, dueled through the drive but shortened stride late. HIGH BLITZ was no factor. STYLISHLY forced the early pace inside but tired in the drive. NEED MONEY DAD reared at the start and was outrun.
