FASTER THAN FLASH stalked the early pace three wide, bid at the half-mile pole, duelled around the turn and was clear in the stretch under steady urging. DOWN THE ROAD saved ground, rallied belatedly but couldn't get past the winner. TEVEZ and CRIMSON SUN stalked the pace and lacked late bids. PATRON SAINT was off awkwardly, pressed the early pace, angled out three wide at the quarter pole but failed to menace. M. J.'S COMMANDER was clear early but gave way in the drive. JAZZED UP and NATIVE AFFAIR were not factors.
