E. JUDITH stalked the pace along the inside,saved ground around the far turn,split horses mid stretch and finished full of run to gain command and draw clear. BOROBETA was away alertly to set the early pace while being rated,dueled till late stretch but was no match for the winner. RIVIE unhurried early,closed willingly along the inside. MAYOMAST pressed the pace,moved up to bid on the far turn but flattened out. CLASSIC CITY DIVA was no factor while five wide. THE LADY WAFFLES trailed and had no rally. PREMIER ROMA raced in good position from four wide,made a move on the far turn to reach the leaders but flattened out.
