### Footnotes

LE DELUGE unrushed early, bid four wide at the half-mile marker, was bumped nearing the eighth pole, then wore down the leader under a mild drive to be clear. SHAKEYOGROOVETHING bid three wide at the three-quarters pole to be clear, then came out nearing the eighth pole to bump the winner and couldn't last. ALBANY ROAD bid three wide at the half-mile pole but faltered in the drive. DOUBLEFOUR bid three wide at the quarter pole but faltered in the drive. CAJUN BAYOU improved position late. NO MINE dueled for a mile before giving way. QUICK TO CHARM bid at the half-mile marker but faltered on the far turn. SILENCE and JACKIE'S CAUSEWAY and MONARCH'S FLAME were never close. NEW REVOLUTION dueled for a mile before giving way.
