TAHOE WARRIOR was clear early, was engaged at the half-mile marker, dueled around the far turn, went clear in the stretch, then lasted under strong urging. ADIRONDACK WARRIOR stalked the early pace inside, bid at the three-eighths pole, rallied and lugged out nine wide in the stretch, came back in and just missed. HISTORICALLY and. RAGS OLD IRON rallied belatedly. STEADY EDDIE raced three wide, bid at the quarter pole, then hung in the drive. RUNAWAY BRUTE had a mild late bid four wide. PERFECT CHEROKEE stalked the early pace inside, moved out three wide on the backstretch to engage the leader, then gave way in the drive. GOOD FAMILY raced evenly four wide. PRINCE RAFFIE passed tired rivals six wide. J T KINGFISHER pressed the pace three wide, then faded on the far turn. STONE EAGLE saved ground to no avail.
