MILKY MAY broke alertly, dueled for the lead in the first quarter, opened a slight advantage to midway in the lane and pulled away in the final eighth. HOBOTO HERO reserved early, made steady gains through the turn, and finished gamely along the rail to gain the place. PHOR PHILIPPE rated off the pacesetters, swung four wide in the turn while steadily advancing, and finished well on the far outside. CAPITAL GAIN raced evenly in mid-field and mounted a mild bid late in the stretch. HALF A WELL tracked the pace to the turn, moved to three wide striking position and flattened out in the drive. DIP MY BEAK made a mild rally from the quarter pole home. RIP RAP slow at the rear of the field to the head of the lane, mounted a belated rally to pass tiring rivals. STAR VIDEO flashed speed briefly and fell back as no threat. STUCK IN TRAFFIC pressed the pace for a half mile and gave out.
