OMAGGIO was sent up to set the pace along the rail,led down the backside while in hand,was challenged on the far turn,dropped back,came again to prevail under left handed pressure in a game effort. GENERALISSIMO stalked the pace from the outside moved up to battled on the far turn,gained a narrow lead,dueled but was outfinished. PEACEFUL CROWD had good position along along the rail,angled out mid stretch and closed willingly. EIGHTEENTHOFMARCH chased the leaders and finished evenly. AUSTONS SURE CURE raced in the second flight,was never a threat. SIR RABBIT was slow early and had no rally along the rail. KABOB was no factor.
