STOLEN POSSE was unrushed early, bid five wide at the top of the stretch, then dueled late and prevailed under steady urging. MY LUCA stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished. COLONIAL LEGACY bid six wide in the stretch and gained the show spot late. BAYSTONE stalked the pace between foes, then had no late bid. KISATCHIE RUN saved ground, then offered a mild late bid. PRINCE ROBEAR was clear early, dueled inside, then gave way in the drive. MORNING GLASS stalked the early pace, bid at the three-quarters pole, dueled outside the leader, then gave way in the stretch. MR. TOPIA stalked the pace, then gave way in the drive.
