

DUVALI stalked the pace between rivals, angled three wide at the quarter pole and was closing late. DOTSERO stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole but faltered late. BURNAWAY saved ground to no avail. DAGBURNIT was fractious while loading, pressed the pace three wide, then gave way in the drive. CAPTAIN'S MANDATE and ART'S VOICE were not factors.
