ROLLIN CATAMINE rushed to contention,angled out on the turn,chased the winner and held the place. AISLE BE had good position from four wide,dropped to the rail at the top of the stretch,closed willingly. ERIE WONDER unhurried early,swung wide on the turn while gaining,failed to sustain his bid. S W IAN passed tiring rivals from six wide. QUALITY PLUS chased from between horses,flattened out. NATIVE SOLEIL showed little along the rail. TWENTYTWO AND TWO pressed the pace from four wide,dropped back and was eased to the wire.
