SWEET LORENA set a well handled pace from the start, was roused in upper stretch then drew off but ducked out in mid stretch and was kept to task in the end. A LITTLE WILD stalked the early pace while racing three wide, made a strong bid on the turn to challenge but was no match for the winner in late stretch. PYRITE GEM chased the early pace while inside, made a bid on the turn then raced evenly in the stretch drive. LOVELY DANIELLA was unhurried early then rallied along the inside on the turn, angled out to be three wide in mid stretch and closed ground willingly in late stretch. HECKUVA GOOD TIME was on the inside on the turn while being no menace. MAC N MAYO was unhurried early while racing two wide on the turn, was no threat in the stretch. CLUELESS BROOK showed brief foot then bore out on the turn and faltered.
