GLEN WILDING was unhurried early behind the dueling leaders,made a steady advance on the inside to reach the leaders,swung out and rallied to finish fastest under strong handling. DANCING TIMBER stalked the pace four wide,made a middle move to duel,was outfinished but was clearly second best. FAITHFUL FLYER raced in the middle of the pack,moved up and closed willingly from five wide. WAVEBREAKER was allowed to settle, trailed, saved ground but failed to respond. BETTERN BISCUITS vied for the lead along the inside, pressed the pace on the backside,came up empty. FOREVER GRACE was hustled along to get the lead,gave way from her effort.
