GHOST RIDER IN RED pressed the pace from four wide, moved up to duel on the far turn, shook clear and gained command under strong left handed pressure. GETALONG was unhurried early, raced six wide on the turn, rallied while remaining wide to get up for the place but was no match for the winner. FRIDAYDATHIRTEENTH had good position, dueled in the stretch but weakened. ZACH AT THE RACK was hustled along, chased the leaders, faltered. DANCING IN GERARDA raced in the second flight, best his stride late along the inside. ON THE PROWL failed to respond from six wide. CARSON GUY set a pressured pace, dueled and flattened out. TIM'S LAST CHANCE was no threat.
