KEELYANDKOYSPRAYER raced three wide, rallied at the top of the stretch and was up late under a strong drive. LUNA DIOSA vied three wide, bid at the quarter pole to be clear late, then was just beaten. MY STAMP bore out at the start, vied early between rivals, then lacked a late bid. TIZ OUR DREAM was off awkwardly, raced four wide, then closed late. JAZZUNTA raced evenly three wide. PABST ANNIE was bumped at the start, rallied five wide at the quarter pole, then hung in the drive. PATTON'S STAR stalked the pace three wide, then faded in the drive. EMILY'S TUNE saved ground to no avail. WILD TIGRESS was impeded at the start, vied inside, then was steadied at the seven-sixteenths pole and gave way. ROSAMONTE was impeded at the start, stalked the pace inside, then faded. UNSPEAKABLE saved ground to no avail.
