#### Footnotes

EMPIRE EXPRESS stalked the pace between foes, bid three wide at the half-mile marker, then drew off late under a mild drive. GREAT SHOT raced three wide, rallied late seven wide but was not a match. CAJUN PRIZE stalked the pace outside of the leader for a half mile, bid, duelled inside the winner in the stretch, then gave way late. SPARKLING SPRINGS pressed the pace three wide, then gave way in the stretch. BLUES BROTHER was unrushed early, then had a mild late bid. DONT TELL KITTEN improved position late nine wide. INSIDER TIP saved ground, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered in the stretch. WALLEY'S WAY was not a factor. ANGLERS REEF stalked the early pace four wide, then faded in the turn. COLD FEET led inside for a half mile before giving way.
