TAPITFORPAR pressed the early pace while racing two wide, rallied strongly in the stretch and drew off in late stretch after a long drive. QUARTERBACK'S CALL chased the early pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the turn then was gaining ground in late stretch to be second best. MY STAMP was hustled along to set a pressured pace from the inside, was hard used then weakened in the stretch drive. SHAKALEENA was bumped at the start then loomed boldly while inside on the turn, stayed inside then angled out three wide in late stretch but was no menace in the end. MISS NEPAL raced three wide on the turn and was no threat. PRINCESS JUANITA broke out at the start and bumped hard then was settled and was no factor. TICKLE BONE chased the early pace while racing four wide on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. CRAFTY TIGRESS broke in at the start and was bumped then was no factor.
