**Footnotes**

PRIVATE EXCHANGE set the pace, drew clear in upper stretch and was ridden out in the end. EVAN'S EMERALD was unhurried early then rallied in the stretch, split horses in late stretch to be second best. MINISTER'S APPEAL rallied three wide on the turn, made a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. DOWNONMAINSTREET rallied three wide on the turn making a bid but weakened in late stretch. COMMON CARRIER was on the inside then rallied three wide in the stretch and was no threat. SLEET AND SASSY ducked in at the start then was settled, swung out to be eight wide in upper stretch and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. TRICKY TUCK was settled then rallied five wide in upper stretch but was no menace. WAR ACTION was pressing the early pace while inside, was bumped hard heading into the turn then steadied and faltered in the stretch. FIRST OSCAR was unhurried early and was no factor. GONE RACIN raced four wide on the turn and was faltered. TRIPLICITY was pressing the early pace while between rivals, was bumped then steadied heading into the turn, dropped back on the turn then stopped in the stretch.
