JEWELS N JEANS rushed to the lead to set the pace at once, held well turning for home, widened when cut loose to lead throughout under a mild drive. ABITA INDIGO chased the winner, failed to gain but held the place. APRIL BLOOMS had good position from four wide, lacked a late response. SPANCILL HILL was well placed, saved ground but had no rally. DELROY'S BARMAID was void of early speed, circled the field and found her best stride late. SHE'S A BLUE HEN broke sharply, was allowed to settle, failed to respond when asked. JUNGLE CAMP showed little along the rail. DAN'S KY BLUE was no factor. MUSICSETSMEFREE was no threat while seven wide in the stretch.
