Footnotes

SUPREME MAKER away alertly, rated just off the leader to the turn, assumed command at the quarter pole and drew off as the clear best. MASTER THE BLUES reserved off the early pace, gained ground from between horses through the turn, waited behind a wall of horses from upper to mid-stretch, got an opening to the inside, dove to rail and was finishing well at the wire. JUANITA SENORITA allowed to settle off the leaders early, ranged up four wide in the turn to loom boldly in mid-stretch and hung late. SAVETHEWILDAGAIN raced near the back of the field to the quarter pole, swung wide in the stretch to be gaining late. MORNING AFTER tracked the pacesetters to mid-stretch and lacked a finishing kick. GO FOR C AND K dropped to the rear of the pack early and made a belated rally in the lane. GOLDEN RULE raced evenly throughout. DON'T STOP TO SHOP stalked the pace from four wide through the turn and weakened in the drive. DIXIEANA MYSTERY rushed up to take the early lead and gave way gradually to the wire. STORMY PERON chased the leaders for a quarter mile, and was through early.
