S W IAN was settled then rallied on the turn, angled out to be three wide then split rivals in mid stretch, closed fast on the outside to be up in the final strides. FAST EL TIGRE set the early pace from the inside, drew off on the turn then was all out in late stretch but failed to last in the final strides. LOST CAMPER stalked the early pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the turn to mid stretch but came up empty in the end. CHIEF NO TELL was unhurried early and saving ground on the turn, rallied along the inside in the stretch to be gaining ground but was no menace in the end. GREATER GLORY was chasing the early pace from the inside, was shuffled back then swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in the stretch. MONARCH DESTINY raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. WESTERN MUSICAL chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up and gave way in the stretch. STAR OF NAVARONE bore out on the turn then was five wide for the stretch drive and lacked a rally. NACHO CORONA was unhurried early while racing extremely wide on the backstretch, was four wide on the turn but was no factor.
