GULLY HILL ROAD chased the leader while along the inside into the turn, angled outside that one turning for home, rallied to make the lead then drew clear under right handed urging while drifting out. DANCEHALL FEVER unhurried along the inside, angled out at the top of the stretch then closed willingly but was too late. IT IS THE WAY never far back, moved up along the rail entering the stretch then finished evenly. TERMINATOR passed tiring rivals. SR. MARVIN failed to menace. CHILLIN VILLAIN had brief speed. DIAMOND JACK BLACK was through after a half. LITE BRIGADE bore out at the start bumping FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE, sprinted to a clear lead, set the pace until the top of the stretch then stopped. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE was bumped at the start then outrun.
