Footnotes

LUCKY LEWIS saved ground, angled out four wide at the three-sixteenths pole, rallied and was up late in the drive. BEATNIK pressed the pace outside of the leader, bid three wide at the top of the stretch, then couldn't hold off the winner. KYMA stalked the pace between rivals, then had a mild late bid while four wide. PROUD VALAY was clear inside, lugged in at the eighth pole, bumping a rival, then gave way late. After an inquiry, PROUD VALAY was disqualified and placed sixth for interference. MOTION TO APPEAL was unrushed early, then improved position late. S S SKITTLES was steadied in the early going inside, stalked the pace inside, bid at the three-eighths, then was taken up at the eighth pole when bumped and hit by a rival's whip. TRADE SECRET bid four wide at the half-mile pole, then faltered in the drive.
