RAVE ON broke alertly to take the lead from the gate, cleared the field down the backside, maintained advantage to the eighth pole and finished willingly to hold the closers safe. CAPTAIN SPANKY stalked the leaders from three wide down the backstretch, moved to challenge four wide in the turn and continued to close through the lane in a good effort. MOONSHINE BLUES lunged at the start to be at the rear of the field early, quickly made up ground to gain a striking position in the turn, swung out five wide in the lane and was going best of all at the wire. LATE DOUBLE JACK slow early to trail the field to the quarter pole, made a belated rally in the stretch. HEAR TO ME stalked the leaders to the turn, moved to challenge through the turn and had no response in the lane. FRONT LINE CENTER reserved off the early pacesetters, saved ground into the lane and made a mild bid up the rail. WINNING QUEST raced evenly while drifting wide in the stretch. FIRE I AM trailed to late in the stretch as a non-factor. RELENTLESS ROB flashed brief speed to press the pace early and gave way to the wire.
