UP TO NO GOOD was in hand on the first turn and stalking the pace, rallied on the far turn while two wide, was in a long sustained drive then gamely dug in and held sway in the end. ONESHOTAWAY was taken in hand soon after the break then was settled on the inside, saved ground on the far turn making a bid and finished well. BIPOLAR EXPRESS was in hand early then moved out three wide in the middle of the backstretch, made a strong bud three wide on the far turn to mid stretch but came up empty in the end. SIR RABBIT was squeezed at the start then was taken in hand to dropped back, was kept to the inside on the far turn, started a run and angled out in mid stretch to be four wide but was no menace in late stretch. TERRIFFICO threw it's head soon after the start then went on up to set the pace, was well rated on the run down the backstretch then gave way in the stretch drive. POP TARRT raced three wide on the first turn while in hand then made a steady fade on the far turn.
