SHMOOZ TALKER pressed the pace while in good position, assumed command turning for home, opened a clear lead, was set down and prevailed after a long drive. CAT SWEEP had good position along the rail, angled out on the turn, finished well in the middle of the track and was gaining on the winner. ZEALOUS YANKEE rushed to the lead down the backside to set the pace along the inside, dueled but weakened in the stretch. WAR WHOOP chased the early pacesetters, moved up into striking position but lacked a late response. RESCUE FINANCING was well placed from six wide, finished evenly. SUAVE FOX had good early speed, tired and gave way. SCORCERER was no factor. GRUNT was outrun. ALI'S QUIET was bumped at the start, trailed, saved ground but had no rally. INSPECTOR MORSE turned in a dull effort.
