Footnotes

BOOM DE YA DA stalked the pace three wide, bid on the far turn to be clear in the stretch and held sway under steady urging. GOOD FAMILY saved ground, angled out three wide on the far turn to bid, then couldn't get to the winner. FARMINGTON pressed the early pace, saving ground, then gave way. VLAST was off awkwardly, then bid six wide in the drive. INTO THE WIND bid between foes on the far turn but hung in the drive. HOUSE OF USHER and HISTORICALLY rallied outside and then faded in the drive. LETSGETITONMON was off awkwardly, then was not a factor. WANA PLAY and SLICK TALKING duelled before giving way on the far turn.
