Footnotes

LE DELUGE reared at the start, snuck up the rail to settle off the pace, stalked inside, angled out four wide at the half-mile marker for running room, bid at three-eighths pole, dueled through the stretch and was clear late under a steady drive. ALBANY ROAD was unrushed early, bid five wide at the half-mile marker, dueled outside the winner but yielded late. DOUBLEFOUR bid four wide at the half-mile marker, then couldn't match strides late. NO MINE stalked the pace between rivals, bid at the quarter pole, then drifted out in the stretch. ROBYN IT faded. SHAKEYGROOVETHING pressed the pace inside for a mile, then gave way. CRYIN' RYAN led between rivals before giving way on the final turn. CREW was not a factor. RAGS OLD IRON pressed the pace three wide before giving way at the half-mile marker. The final time was a track record.
