### Footnotes

AFLEET'S SECRET was unhurried in the early going, had a steady advance to reach the leaders, circled the field, closed fastest of all in the middle of the track to gain command and draw off. KNIGHT'S QUEST was allowed to settle, found his best stride and finished well to be up for second. MATCH STICK was taken back soon after the start, swung wide down the backside, rallied with a quick move from the outside to gain command, battled in the stretch but weakened. DINNER TRAIN pressed the pace, saved ground, lacked a late response. OH MY GOLD had early speed finished, evenly. COUNTRY TOUGH trailed early then was no factor. INTI (URU) chased the pace from four wide, gave way and flattened out. JOHNNY MAESTRO was hustled along to set the early pace, weakened and stopped on the far turn.
