WESLINN was sent right to the front and set a well handled pace, drew off in upper stretch then was kept to task in late stretch. C STREET was unhurried early while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn making a bid then was gaining ground while inside in the stretch. HONEST TRIP chased the early pace while two wide, made a bid on the far turn to mid stretch but came up empty in the end. SUPER CLASS (BRZ) was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be four wide in upper stretch making a bid then flattened out in the drive. BISHOP CASEY was three wide on the backstretch then rallied on the far turn making a bid to upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. DUGAN unhurried early while kept to the outside, was four wide heading into the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. MALKEINU chased the early pace while inside, was used up then gave way on the far turn. APPALACHIAN TRAIL was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch but failed to respond when asked. TIGER SHARK was outrun and being eased up in late stretch.
