MUSICAL MISCHIEF was settled then rallied three wide, was bumped in upper stretch by CRIMSON MARY then was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch. TARA'S AFFAIR chased the early pace while racing two wide, rallied on the turn and gained command in upper stretch, drew off in mid stretch then could not last in the final seventy yards. GRASSHOPPA was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the turn, was gaining ground in the stretch to finished well. KITTY AFLEET was saving ground on the turn then made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat. CRIMSON MARY was inside heading into the turn then rallied two wide, bumped with MUSICAL MISCHIEF then was steadied off heels then made a bid but flattened out in late stretch. HOUR CLASSIC lunged at the start then hustled along but lacked a rally in the stretch. BEAR PRAYER broke sharply to set a fast pace, was used up then stopped in the stretch.
