Footnotes

LADYINBLUE away in good order from the inside, chased the early pace from the inside, inched closer up the backstretch, gained command entering the second turn, opened a clear margin entering the stretch and steadily drew clear under steady urging. JERMIDY unhurried early while inside, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the drive but could not reach the winner. DANCING TIMBER allowed to settle early, inched closer entering the second turn, responded to pressure but was no match late. COUNTRY KAT could only pass tiring rivals. VICTORIOUS HALO broke well from the outside, set the early pace and tired. FAITHFUL FLYER was no factor. MORGHYN forced the early pace outside and gave way.
