JUS TIGER'S GOLD was settled in the early going then rallied on the turn while saving ground, was in a strong drive along the inside then moved out to split rivals in late stretch and gamely proved best in the end. FRANK THE TANK was five wide on the turn then rallied and was gaining ground while four wide in late stretch to finish strong. ROVING was two wide on the turn then angled inside in upper stretch, was in a long drive to gain a narrow lead in late stretch but hung in the end. PRESS THE LIMIT set the early pace while racing off the rail, drew off between calls then weakened in late stretch. FAST EL TIGRE pressed the early pace while racing three wide, was used up and gave way in the stretch. WESTERN MUSICAL was well placed while racing four wide on the turn then failed to respond in the stretch when asked. MONARCH DESTINY was inside and saving ground on the turn but was no factor in the stretch. NATIVE SOLEIL raced three wide on the turn and was no threat. RAIN OF GLORY raced two wide on the turn and was no threat. ERIE WONDER raced six wide on the turn and was outrun.
