THE LADY WAFFLES was settled in the early going then started a run on the far turn while three wide, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch then was in a strong drive on the outside and got up in the nick of time. CLASSIC CITY DIVA was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while inside, was in a strong drive along the rail then slipped through to gain command in late stretch but was outnodded in the final stride. KINDLING dueled for the lead while inside, was hard used while in a long drive throughout the stretch drive but weakened in late stretch. GLEN WILDING dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long hard drive but tired in late stretch. MISS MAFIOSO was unhurried early and kept to the inside on the backstretch, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch but was no menace in the stretch. DANCING TIMBER was unhurried early and raced two wide throughout but was no threat. SHE'S CHEROKEE pressed the early pace while three wide, was hard used then gave way on the far turn.
