FURKA PASS was settled in the early going then started a run on the turn, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch then was in a strong drive on the outside and was up in the final strides. BANG BANG BANG vied for the lead while three wide then was in a long drive while two wide in the stretch, dug in gamely in late stretch but was outfinished in deep stretch. KODA broke out and bumped at the start then vied for the lead while inside, was in a long sustained drive from the inside in the stretch but tired in deep stretch. JUKE JOINT stalked the early pace while inside then rallied three wide on the turn, was gaining ground in the stretch while drifting out but came up empty in deep stretch. VAN LEROY rallied while four turn making a bid then flattened out in the drive. LUCKY DRAGON was bumped at the start then vied for the early lead from between rivals, dropped back heading into the turn then tired in the drive. TERRIFFICO was bumped from both sides at the start then raced five wide on the turn and was outrun.
