FASTER THAN FLASH rushed up to get the early lead along the inside,was well rated on the front end,held rivals safe when set down to lead throughout while kept to pressure. SUPER NEKIA had good early position,saved ground,dug in late but was no match for the winner. SOUTHERN ARCH was unhurried early,finished well from between horses. APOLLONIUS was void of early speed,saved ground,found his best stride late and closed fast. THE WRECKER raced in the second flight while five wide,had no rally. OUT IN THE OPEN stalked the pace four wide,made a middle move to challenge,bid mid stretch but hung late. EL INMIGRANTE was away alertly,chased the winner,gave way. FAST APPROACH was well placed from between horses,dropped back on the turn.
