ELECTRIC CITY stalked the pace for a half, assumed command when ready, responded when set down to edge clear and prevail under steady handling. SMART SIGHT was squeezed back at the start then allowed to settle, made a steady advance, finished well in the final yards to gain the place. LITTLE PHILLY bore out at the start bothering rival, rushed to the lead, set the pace, weakened in the stretch. STARDAZZLE was slow early, swung wide on the turn, angled in to the rail and had a mild rally. FLAVOR OF THE DAY had good position, saved ground, lacked a late response. WOLFIE'S GHOST was no factor while six wide. EVE THE DANCER was outrun along the rail. SUBDUE raced in the middle of the pack, faded. LIL CHAMP chased the leaders, dropped back on the turn and stopped.
