LADY LOHR rushed up to take command shortly away from the gate, cleared the pace pressure in the turn while slowing down the pace, fought gamely in a drive to the wire to just hold on. STORM ON BYE reserved off the pace early, made a steady wide advance in the turn, swung out five wide and finished fast to just miss. MISO BAD tracked the leaders from the rail throughout and rallied well in the stretch to be up for the show. UNFLINCHING tracked the leaders while caught wide through the turn, moved in upper stretch to threaten and hung late. CARIBBEAN CANDY rated off the pace to the top of the lane, swung extremely wide for the drive and made a mild bid late in the lane. SHANANA slow early to be at the rear of the field, made a late gain down the stretch. MAID FOR JOE pressed the pace from three wide to the quarter pole and gave way in the drive. TAKE INTEREST broke way to the outside, dropped back to trail and proved no threat. WISH TO OPINE pressed the pace for the first quarter and weakened.
