SLEWY GIRL broke well from the inside to stalk the early pace, inched closer up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the drive, responded when sat down for the drive and was along in time the final strides. ROCKET MA'ME chased the early pace from the outside, crept closer up the backstretch, reached a forward position entering the second turn, made a bid to gain a short advantage entering the drive but could not last in a game effort. WINLOC'S HAIL MARY unhurried early while outside rivals, steadily advanced up the backstretch, reached a forward position from the far outside entering the drive, responded but flattened out late. SWEET DIECISEIS outrun early, advanced inside entering the drive, responded and finished well but too late. TASTEE BUBBLES forced the early pace from the outside, remained in a forward position entering the drive but had nothing left. TALLY ME OUT was no factor. MITSZI JOE broke well from the outside to set the early pace and tired.
