LAST TYCHE stalked the early pace from between horses,moved closer turning for home,had a late rally to grab the lead and drew clear under steady pressure. SCRUB ISLAND had good early position,saved ground down the backside,split horses and finished well to gain the place. ADIOS MY LADY was allowed to settle,made a steady advance,offered a late rally four wide. CRIMSON DOON void of early speed, trailed for three quarters,passed tiring rivals. TRULY BROADWAY was away alertly to set a pressured pace, weakened after a half. LEFT ME BREATHLESS settled in the middle of the pack, angled out on the far turn, failed to respond. NO TEARS IN HEAVEN pressed the pace from the outside, gave way.
