FRISCO STAR was away alertly and allowed to settle into stride, stalked the early leader while in hand, responded when asked turning for home, finished full of run to quickly draw clear while being ridden out. SHAKE THE BANK was away in good order, showed good early speed to gain command, was rated on the lead, gave up lead to winner but was clearly second best while no match for the winner. CRAFTY MARK slow early, offered a mild rally in the stretch. TWO CATS was well placed from between horses, lacked a late response. DISCO INDY unhurried early, offered no rally. BULLET BREW void of early speed, trailed in a dull effort. FLIGHT CAPTAIN (GB) had good early speed, saved ground but gave way.
