Footnotes

SHOULDNTUBDOINTHIS stalked the early pace from the outside, responded to pressure entering the turn, split rivals upper stretch and finished with a rush to be in time. WICKED WALT up close from the outside, responded entering the drive, found his best stride deep stretch but could not withstand the winner. ODD SECRET dueled from the outside early, dueled through the stretch but could not match strides. IRON ROCKETTE well placed from the inside, responded entering the stretch along the rail and finished well but too late. CELTIC STRIDER never far back, made a bid entering the drive but could not keep pace. DANCE FOR MILITARY dueled from between foes, remained forward entering the drive but tired. SEISMOGRAPHER up close outside, had no late response. CRAZY HORSE WILL could only pass tiring rivals. TOO WILD was no factor. FAST BOURNE was no threat. CAMP BUBBA dueled from the inside but gave way in the drive. STEVEN'S AFLEET dueled from between foes early but gave way.
